Eligibility :

Should have passed with 50% marks in 12 th Std. or equivalent with minimum and 55% aggregate marks in Maths, Physics & English.	Should have passed with 45% marks in 12 th Std. or equivalent with minimum and 50% aggregate marks in Maths, Physics & English.

Note :- In case SC/ST/OEC candidates do not qualify for admission to the reserved seats, such seats would be filled up with candidates from the General Category.

3. Medical :
Selected candidates may join with Class II Medical. However, they will have to clear and submit Class – I Medical Fitness Certificate subsequently. Please check DGCA website for the list of approved Centres/Doctors for Class-I & II Medical available.
4. Selected candidates shall submit Psychoactive substance test result at the time of joining.

Selection process will be based on either (a) and (b) below or (b) alone, as the case may be depending on the number of applications received.

Written Test : At allotted centre, which will be intimated in due course

Syllabus for Written Test :

General English, Maths, Physics, Geography, Reasoning (IQ) & General Aviation (objective -type questions only)

(a) Qualifying Marks in Written Test :

The cut-off marks for SC/ST candidates will be 5% less than the cut-off marks secured by the last candidate in the General Category.

(b) Interview : Date will be intimated in due course

All shortlisted candidates will be required to produce the following documents in *original* as well as one attested photocopy of each document at the time of interview

- i) Proof of Date of Birth (such as 10th Class Certificate)
- ii) 10th Mark sheet
- iii) 10 + 2 Mark sheet
- iv) Caste Certificate for SC/ST Candidates

Applications are to be downloaded from the Academy website. Duly filled application along with the prescribed application fee and documents required may be sent to the Academy via post.

8. **Application Fee :**

Application fee is Rs. 5,500/- for General Category. For SC/ST/OEC candidates application fee is Rs. 3,000/-. Payment is to be made through a Demand Draft in favour of the Executive Vice Chairman, Rajiv Gandhi Academy for Aviation Technology, Thiruvananthapuram (Payable at Thiruvananthapuram)

5. Incomplete applications or applications received after the last date will be rejected.
